LPP listing is to certify purebred status as is reasonably possible using visual inspection for the purpose of entering sanctioned sporting events at ADBSI Sanctioned Shows to achieve points toward titles of excellence. LPP identification card will be sent displaying a photo of the dog with ownership information once the dog is accepted.

## LPP application must be accompanied with the following documentation:

Name on Card

- 1. Two or more recent color photographs. Photos submitted (color only) must be of good quality for easy visual breed identification of dog. One photo featuring the dog from the side, in a standing position and a photo featuring a full view of the dog from the front. Position can be standing or sitting, as long as the photo shows the dog's entire front, (head to feet). One of these photos will be featured on the LPP card, so photos must be of the highest quality possible.
- 2. Certification that the dog has been either spayed or neutered. If spay/neuter certificate is unavailable, a signed document of spay/neuter verification supplied by a veterinarian will be accepted.
